outdoor service from 9:00-9:30 am in the Huntington Pkwy parking lot (weather permitting). Each service will include prayer, scripture, a message for all ages, and of course, singing! Please park in the Old Georgetown Rd lot at the north end of the building for this service.

11:00 am: Blended Worship (in-person & online)

Our faith community joins for blended worship each Sunday at 11:00 am with music from our Praise Band, Sanctuary Choir, and Bethesda Bells, along with occasional presentations by the Youth Praise



Band, *Common Ground*, our acoustic group, *Church Folk*, and the Children's Choir. Our service includes congregational singing, a children's message, prayer, scripture, and a message from the pastor. 7:00 pm: Evensong Worship (during Advent)

During the season of Advent, BUMC will offer a third service on Sundays at 7:00 pm. This service is more contemplative in nature and features acoustic music led by our Church Folk group and other musicians.

A Note About COVID: Per Montgomery County rules, masks are required indoors regardless of vaccination status. BUMC also requires mask wearing outdoors when children under 12 are present. Our Re-Entry Team continues to closely monitor CDC and local health department recommendations and may institute additional safety measures if indicated. WORSHIP FAQs

What do most people wear to worship? Please feel free to dress in whatever is comfortable for you. You will see people worshiping in jeans and also in dresses and suits.

What do I do if my child cries during worship? You are always welcome to bring your babies, toddlers and young children into worship (even when they cry!). If you (or your child) need a break, feel free to step out into the Narthex (at the rear of the church) or Lonnie's Lobby (exit through the front door on the right of the Sanctuary). We also offer

nursery care for infants, toddlers, and preschoolers starting at 8:45 am on Sunday morning. Our nursery is staffed by two regular caregivers who are both vaccinated. The nursery is located in **Room 105** (as you



exit the front of the Sanctuary through Lonnie's Lobby, it will be the first classroom on the left). Coloring books, crayons and other materials are available in the Narthex for older children to use during worship. An usher will be happy to assist you!

What about Communion? BUMC practices an open table which means that all are welcome to participate in Communion, regardless of whether they belong to our church or are part of the United Methodist Church. Communion is offered on the first Sunday of the month. Congregants remain in their pew and the ushers come through the Sanctuary with individual packages that contain a gluten-free wafer and juice.
